

## **Driving Directions\* to The PEAK Center**

**From Center City, Philadelphia-** From I-76 W merge onto I-476 N via exit number 331B toward Plymouth Meeting (toll road). Continue on I-476 N for 14.7 miles and exit at 31 Lansdale. At the light turn left on to Sumneytown Pike/PA 63 for .2 miles. Turn left onto Forty Foot Road/PA 63 for 1.6 miles. Turn right onto Welsh Road/PA 63 for 2 miles. After passing through light at Cannon Avenue, pass Richardson Avenue then **turn left onto Wood Street** (National Auto store and Molly Maguires Pub on the corners) to ample meter parking at the rear entrance from the Madison Parking lot.

**From Northeast Philadelphia-** From Roosevelt Blvd proceed to US-1 N. Merge onto the Pennsylvania Turnpike W/I-276 W toward I-76 Harrisburg/I-476/Allentown/West Exits 27-1/North Exits 31-39 for 13.2 miles. Merge onto PA -309 N via exit number 339 toward and past Ambler for 6.1 miles. Follow directions from Eastern Montgomery County (below).

**From Eastern Montgomery County** Either take the Route 309 expressway from Ambler or from Willow Grove take Route 63 West. When the expressway portion of Route 309 ends you want to stay on the right and go into the jug handle before the first traffic light that you come to so that you can go West onto Route 63. Turn left onto W Welsh Road/PA-63 for 4 miles. (If you are coming from Willow Grove just stay straight on Route 63 across Route 309 at the 309 Cinema.) Continue past several shopping centers into downtown Lansdale. Immediately after crossing the rail road tracks at the Lansdale train station, make a right to the Madison Parking lot for ample metered parking at rear entrance.

**From Western Montgomery County** Take either Route 63, Sumneytown Pike or Route 73, Skippack Pike East until you get to Valley Forge Road (Route 363). Turn left onto Valley Forge Road and take that into Lansdale. At the intersection of Valley Forge Road and Route 63 (Main Street) turn right onto Main Street. Stay on Main Street past light at Cannon Avenue and a few blocks after that in downtown business district turn left onto Richardson Avenue and right at the next full street into the Madison Parking lot.

**From Conshohocken or other exits of Rt. 476 (Blue Route)** Take Route 476 north until it connects with Route 476 North (the NE extension of the PA turnpike). . Exit at 31, Lansdale. At the light turn left on to Sumneytown Pike/PA 63 for .2 miles. Turn left onto Forty Foot RD/PA 63 for 1.6 miles. Turn right onto Welsh Road/PA 63 East for 2 miles. Turn left onto Richardson Avenue and right at the next full street into the Madison Parking lot.

**From Wayne-** Traveling Northwest on S. Warner Road turn sharp left onto Devon Park Road for .2 miles. Turn right onto County Line Road for .9 miles. Take I-76 E for 3.8 miles. Merge onto I-476 N via exit 331 B towards Plymouth Meeting (toll road) for 14.8 miles. Exit at 31, Lansdale. At the light turn left on to Sumneytown Pike/PA 63 for .2 miles. Turn left onto Forty Foot RD/PA 63 for 1.6 miles. Turn right onto Welsh

Road/PA 63 East for 2 miles. After passing through light at Cannon Avenue, pass Richardson Avenue and turn left onto Wood Street (National Auto store and Molly Maguires Pub on the corners) to ample meter parking at the rear entrance from the Madison Parking lot..

**From Allentown-** Merge onto US-22 W towards Harrisburg. Take the I-476 toll road, Pennsylvania turnpike toward Philadelphia and Scranton. Merge onto I-476 S toward Philadelphia and South/East-West turnpike for 26.7 miles (toll road). Exit at 31, Lansdale. At the light turn left on to Sumneytown Pike/PA 63. Turn left onto Forty Foot RD/PA 63 for 1.6 miles. Turn right onto Welsh Road/PA 63 for 2 miles. After passing Cannon Avenue light left onto Richardson Avenue and right at the next full street into the Madison Parking lot.

**From Doylestown-** Follow 202 S toward Lansdale. Turn right onto Cowpath Road/PA-463 for 1.5 miles. Turn left onto Broad Street for another 1.5 miles. Turn right onto W. Main Street/PA 63 for .1 miles. After crossing the rail road tracks at the Lansdale Train station, turn right to the Madison Parking lot to rear entrance for ample metered parking.

**\*The PEAK Center is a short walk from the Lansdale stop of the R5 SEPTA rail line. Meters in Madison Municipal lot are not used after 6 PM. Green meters closest to the building take nickels and dimes and are only for 2 hours. Blue meters take a quarter for 3 hours or 2 quarters for 6 hours. Expired meter fines have recently gone up to \$20 so plan your time appropriately.**
